Approximately 30 scholarships of \$1,000 per semester (renewable for up to four semesters) are available each year for Honors students who commit to completion of the Honors Program. The scholarship amount of \$1000 is intended for honors students taking at least twelve credit hours and are therefore considered full-time. Students taking less than twelve credit hours, and are therefore considered part-time, are subject to a reduced or “prorated” amount. With every three credit hours equaling \$250, a student with three credit hours would receive \$250, six credit hours receives \$500, nine credit hours receives \$750, while students with twelve credit hours or above will receive the full amount of \$1000. Renewal of the scholarship will be based on both academic performance and satisfactory progress toward completion of the program. These scholarships have no work requirements and may be coupled with other scholarships and/or financial aid. Completing this Scholarship Application will enable the Honors Committee to consider you for the Honors Scholarship. Honors Scholarship applications are considered as they are received. If you wish to be considered for one of the program’s scholarships, you must complete this application in its entirety. The Committee will not consider incomplete applications. Applicants will be notified as soon as processing is complete. For the fall term, students will generally be notified by September. General information, amounts of awards, and rules and regulations of the programs will be forwarded to recipients at this time.

## **Freshman Students**

If you are a high school senior or have never previously attended college, you must have a Motlow College Admissions Application on file in the Admissions Office, a high school transcript through at least the first semester of your senior year, and your ACT scores, if you are under 21 years of age. High school seniors must have additional information (section E) completed by a high school representative prior to submission. You must pursue a degree, commit to the completion of at least 15 hours of Honors credits by graduation, continue to enroll in Honors courses, and have a minimum 3.0 GPA at graduation.

## **Transfer Students:**

If you are a transfer student or are re-enrolling, you must have a Motlow College Admissions Application and all required college transcripts on file in the Admissions Office. You must pursue a degree, commit to the completion of at least 15 hours of Honors credits by graduation, continue to enroll in Honors courses, and have a minimum 3.0 GPA at graduation.

## **Current Students:**

Currently enrolled students need only to complete the Honors Scholarship Application. You must pursue a degree, commit to the completion of at least 15 hours of Honors credits by graduation, continue to enroll in Honors courses, and have a minimum 3.0 GPA at graduation.
